### What's this message about?

2. "This day you will be with me in Paradise." (Luke 23:43)
3. "Woman, behold your son." (John 19:26-27)
4. "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?" (Mark 15:34; Matthew 27:46)
5. "I thirst." (John 19:28)
6. "It is finished." (John 19:30)
7. "Into your hands I commit my spirit." (Luke 23:46)

### Questions to ponder:

- *What do you think was the main point of Matt's sermon?*
  - *Why do you think that Jesus' last words are so important?*
  - *Which "last word" resonates with you the most? Why?*
  - *How does knowing this affect your relationship with God?*
1. *What does this say about God?*
  2. *What does this say about me?*
  3. *What does this say about how God wants me to be?*
